PLAN	PROCESS FOR CLAIMS WITHOUT A PRESCRIBER INFORMATION (e.g., a prescription/fiscal order is not required)
Affinity Health Plan	Submit claim with blank prescriber information or Submit claim using the Pharmacy NPI in place of the prescriber NPI
Amerigroup	Submit claim with blank prescriber information
Amida Care	Submit claim using the Pharmacy NPI in place of the prescriber NPI
CDPHP	Submit claim with blank prescriber information or Submit claim using the Pharmacy NPI in place of the prescriber NPI
Excellus/ Univera Community Health Plan	Submit claim with blank prescriber information or Submit claim using the Pharmacy NPI in place of the prescriber NPI
Fidelis Care	Fidelis Care does not cover family planning products. These products should be billed to Medicaid FFS. Pharmacy can leave prescriber information blank.
Healthfirst	Submit claim using the Pharmacy NPI in place of the prescriber NPI
Health Plus	Submit claim using the Pharmacy NPI in place of the prescriber NPI
HealthNow, Inc	Submit claim using the Pharmacy NPI in place of the prescriber NPI
HIP/ Emblem Health	Submit claim using the Pharmacy NPI in place of the prescriber NPI
Hudson Health Plan	Submit claim using the Pharmacy NPI in place of the prescriber NPI
Independent Health	Submit Dummy Prescriber ID "ZZ3282100" in the prescriber field
MetroPlus Health Plan	Pharmacy can leave prescriber information blank
MVP	Submit claim using the Pharmacy NPI in place of the prescriber NPI
Neighborhood Health Providers	Submit pharmacy information in the prescriber field
NY Presbyterian System Select Health	Pharmacy can leave prescriber information blank

WellCare Health Plans, Inc	Submit claim using NPI# 5254402753 or any other NPI in the prescriber field
